Shri G.S. Institute of Technology and Science, Indore was established in 1952 as Technical Institute offering Diploma course in Engineering. Later on this Institute developed into leading technological Institute offering Under Graduate and post-graduate degrees in various branches of Engg.& Technology besides Ph.D programme. Admission to the B.E. four years programme is done on the basis of Pre-Engineering Test (PET) conducted by professional Board set up by the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh.

The Institute is recognized by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) University Grants Commission (New Delhi) and the Government of Madhya Pradesh. On the recommendations of the above bodies the Institute got Autonomous status in the year 1989. Under the Autonomous status Institute conducts its own examinations and recommends the name of the students to the University for the award of Degree. Earlier this Institute was affiliated to Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalya, Indore (formerly known as University of Indore) up to 21/08/2000. Thereafter by the Act of (Act 13 of 1998) the Madhya Pradesh Govt. legislature, a separate Technical University for imparting Technical Education in the state came into existence vide Madhya Pradesh Govt. Gazette notification No. 509 dated 22/08/2000 according to which this Institute has also come under the purview of Rajiv Gandhi Proudhyogiki Vishwavidyalaya (University of Technology of M.P.) Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh, India.

This Institute does not follow grading system. In order to pass examination for any semester a candidate must obtain at least;

- a) 35% of the marks in Theory paper.
- b) 60% of the marks in Sessional/Class Work.
- c) 50% of the marks in Practical.

The aggregate of 2nd, 3rd and 4th Year is added together for purpose of division in the degree and the division is awarded by taking into account 10%, 20%, 100% of total marks obtained in 2nd, 3rd and 4th year examinations respectively. Candidates securing 75% or more marks in combined aggregate will be declared to have passed the degree examination in first Division with Distinction, 65% and above in 1st Division and below 65% in 2nd Division.

A candidate is assessed on the basis of marks obtained by him/her in the exempted subjects with the marks obtained by him/her in the subject in which he/she reappeared and passed at the subsequent examination. No candidate shall be permitted to appear in an Exam. of any subject unless he/she completes the academic requirement:

- a) Satisfactory attendance and
- b) Minimum passing marks in class-work and Sessional-work.

The medium of instruction of the course is English.
